

**COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
CITY OF TITONKA  
February 11, 2014**

Titonka City Council met in emergency session Tuesday, February 11, 2014 at 7:00 P.M. at City Hall. An emergency meeting was necessary to address the problem of frozen water service lines in the city.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Boyken with council members Etherington, Hamilton, Johnson, Lee and Zwiefel present. Also attending was Cory and Heidi Larson, Paul Heyer, and Clerk Karen Hamilton.

Motion was made by Etherington and seconded by Lee to approve the agenda. 5 ayes, 0 nays. Carried.

The council discussed the problem of frozen water service lines.

Motion was made by Etherington and seconded by Johnson to have the City and property owner each pay half of the costs to clear the frozen water service lines. 5 ayes, 0 nays. Carried.

The council suggests that homeowners keep water running to prevent service lines from freezing.

Motion was made by Lee and seconded by Hamilton to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 7:26 P.M.
