

**COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

Titonka City Council met in special session Thursday, January 28, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. at City Hall.

Motion was made by LaGue, seconded by Harms, to approve the purchase of a new pump and motor unit for the boiler in Buffalo Creek Activity Center, at a price not to exceed \$1,500. 5 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

The City budget was discussed.

Motion was made by LaGue and seconded by Watkins to set the public hearing date of February 11, 2021 for the proposed property tax levy. 5 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Trunkhill, seconded by Ohrtman. Meeting adjourned at 7:37 P.M.
